The game “EU Security: Outlook 2024” simulates the EU Summit in Brussels, where participants negotiate about EU security and defense, sanctions against Russia, and military support to Ukraine. In the panel “Youth Empowerment as the Key to Democratic Recovery of Ukraine”, we look at concrete projects in Ukraine, Moldova, and Germany to explore how youth empowerment might act as a catalyst for return and reintegration.
